



Ballistic Shield Familiarization

This two-day course is designed to familiarize students with the use of Ballistic Shields. At the conclusion of the course students should be able to demonstrate a working knowledge of operating a shield, moving with a shield, manipulating the shield with duty weapon and overall knowledge base of shield operations.

CONCEPTS & SKILLS: Shield Positions, Duty Weapon Positioning, Transitioning to Weapon Hand

The tactical shield can be a very effective tool for tactical teams as well as first responders utilizing during active shooter situations even though many agencies fail to understand the full potential of this versatile piece of equipment. This course will explore the many uses of the tactical shield

EQUIPMENT NEEDED & PROPER ATTIRE: Agency ballistic shield, 350 rds. handgun (required), ballistic vest, eye protection, ear protection, BDU's or training uniform as per department policy, hydration drinks, meal bars, notebook, pen, **Rifle or Sub Gun (optional for familiarization) 100 rds.**

RTS Tactical Shields will be onsite for use, however, due to departmental SOP's. It is recommended students bring their current shields provided by their agency.

Tuesday morning course will start at 9:00am with a Power Point presentation in a classroom then move to the range with hands on & deploying the shield conducted at the range (or suitable area).
